PRODUCT STORAGE

It is the responsibility of the end user to document and maintain BelloXO™ in its original packaging. BelloXO™ should be at 4-20°C prior to use. BelloXO™ should not be stored at 4-20°C for an excess of 14 days.

INDICATIONS

BelloXOTM is intended for topical use only as determined by a physician.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

In order to reduce the risk of complications, BelloXOTM should not be administered in the presence of active infections. BelloXOTM should not be administered to pregnant women, women planning to be pregnant within four months, or women currently breast feeding. As general practice, it is best to have IM Benadryl and Epinephrine available in the event of an anaphylactic event.

ADVERSE REACTIONS

Although donor cells are evaluated and processed, the donor screening methods are limited and may not detect all diseases. Therefore, complications of allograft may include, but are not limited to:

- · Transmission of diseases of unknown etiology
- Transmission of unknown infectious agents such as viruses, bacteria and fungi

Adverse reactions or outcomes that potentially involve the use of Bell0XOTM should be reported immediately to Regen Suppliers.

RECOMMENDED INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF BelloXOTM

These recommendations are designed only to serve as a general guideline. They are not intended to supersede institutional protocols or professional clinical judgment concerning patient care.

PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Maintain BelloXOTM at -20°C or colder for long term storage and transfer to 4°C prior to use.
- 2. Remove the vial from the packaging.
- 3. Allow contents to thaw at room temperature until flowable.
- 4. BelloXO™ is ready for use.
